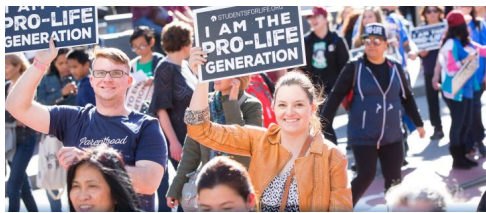

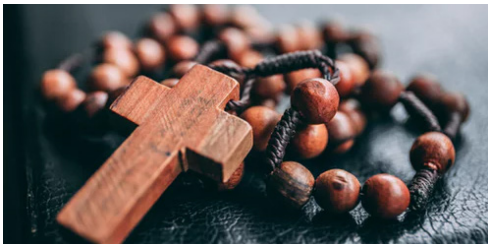
Typically, the full-time house parents are off duty every fourth weekend from 9:00 AM Friday through 7:00 PM Sunday. Relief parents, on a rotational schedule, fill in during this time. They may also be asked to be on a call list to help fill in when the house parents are on vacation and/or sick.

Relief parents receive an hourly wage, all legally mandated benefits and a compensation package that includes a private suite and all meals for the days on duty.

La planificación familiar natural (PFN) es el término que se maneja para referirse a los métodos de planificación familiar que son naturales, científicos, moralmente buenos y eficaces para lograr o posponer embarazos. No son los antiguos métodos naturales que no tienen bases científicas y no funcionan. Estos métodos están basados en la observación de los signos y síntomas naturales de las fases fértiles e infértiles del ciclo menstrual de la mujer.

La PFN no utiliza las drogas, los artefactos o procedimientos quirúrgicos que comúnmente son ineficaces y dañinos para la salud. Además, éstos respetan la naturaleza unitiva y procreativa del acto conyugal según el diseño de Dios del amor conyugal.

Estos métodos le ayudarán a lograr o posponer embarazos de una manera efectiva y sin las dañinas consecuencias de todos los anticonceptivos. Además, les permitirá disfrutar y vivir su sexualidad a plenitud y fortalecer su relación mutua y con Dios. Si está pensando en casarse, está en preparación matrimonial, vive con su pareja o está casado/a, tiene hijos o no, ¡NO LO PIENSE MÁS!
