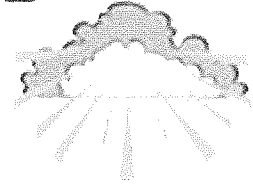

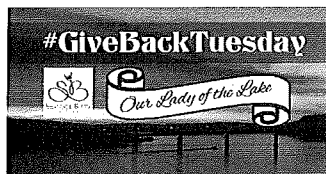

Easter celebrates the resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Our faith teaches us many things about our God as the loving creator who has given us life. The Sabbath of the People of Israel honored creation in imitating God's rest on the seventh day. Christians have a new Sabbath: on the first day of the New Creation when Jesus, the first born from the dead rises from the tomb and breathes life into the Church with the fire of the Holy Spirit. Therefore Christians gather each Sunday throughout the year to recall that first Easter and keep the commandment to honor the Sabbath.

As we gather as God's People in great numbers this Easter Sunday to celebrate, we are mindful of the great gift that Christ has given us in the promise of resurrection. We are filled with joy in the knowledge of this promise: like Mary Magdalene rushing back from the empty tomb to share her joy; like the surprised disciples in Emmaus who recognized Jesus in the breaking of the bread; like the humbled Peter who experienced the forgiveness of Christ for his denial and replaced that three-fold denial with a profound expression of his love for Christ.

Our parish exists because we know the truth of the Easter message and wish to share that message with others. We are embarking on a fifty day pilgrimage during this Easter Season. During that time, our church will host many events that extend the joy and graces of Easter: We will be confirming our high school students on April 8 as we host our new bishop. This is the season of First Communion, where our young students finally join with the whole community in full communion. We will be celebrating baptisms, extending the grace of Easter to children and infants as they are immersed in the saving waters of baptism. And our whole community is invited to deepen their faith and knowledge of Christ with continued opportunities of renewal in CRHP weekends, a ladies retreat and continued participation in our Discipleship Groups as we study the online resources at formed.org.

I invite all our parishioners to enter more deeply into the mystery of Christ during the coming Easter Season, especially in being faithful to attendance at Sunday mass and participating in faith formation opportunities. May the peace that Christ breathed into his apostles come into your heart. May the first of the Holy Spirit strengthen you to deep your faith and share the good news of Christ's resurrection with all you meet.
