New Security Features for the Office Entrance

The parish staff and administration commission have been reflecting upon the safety and security for our facilities. All of us are keenly aware events in recent history in the US and throughout the world where the safety and security of public spaces and especially houses of worship has been compromised. We are committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our parishioners, visitors, staff and volunteers. We will continue to develop a more comprehensive plan for safety, security and well-being for our parish community, but we are ready now to implement a few changes. These changes will have a two-fold effect: facilitating the access to the building of the staff and many volunteers who come and work at church throughout the day and in the evening, and also to control access to the facility to strengthen the security and enhance the safety of our community.

The main point of entry for our facilities is the back parking lot, office entrance. Current practice is to keep all doors locked throughout the day, except for the doors leading to the ramp up to the Fellowship Hall. These main entrance doors are out of the view of office staff during the workday. This makes it more difficult to control access to the facility, especially areas where staff are working during the day. In addition to this structural issue, there is the procedural matter of issuing many duplicate keys to so many different people for access to the church outside of office hours.

I have been discussing all these issues with the administration commission which has several members with professional experience in safety and security. The commission has requested and received a bid for the installation of a new electronic access entry system and a closed circuit video monitoring (with no recording capabilities at this time) of the office entrance. With this system we will be following the practice of the Diocese of Jefferson City at the diocesan offices and the cathedral offices and school. The system will cost about \$8,000. Funds will be from the rebate that will come to us through the generosity of parish donors to the Catholic Stewardship Appeal. We have also applied for a \$2,500 grant from the Diocese of Jefferson City from a fund that has been established specifically to assist parishes in safety and security.

In the weeks to come, we will finish the implementing the plan and inform the community about the new policies and procedures that will take place. I thank the Administration Commission for their work on this project and look forward to continuing to enhance the safety and security of our parish.

Playground Not Quite Finished: the new play area for the parish that is Joey Adams's Eagle Scout project looks ready, but in fact is not quite finished. We cannot allow access until several more features are added and there is an inspection by the directory of facilities for the Diocese of Jefferson City. Among other things, the fence that is to go on the far side of the play area still needs to be installed. It is a steep, rocky slope with substantial brush. A fence will keep people from accidentally going down the hill. Please respect the perimeter tape that has been placed around the play area and do not allow children to enter. When everything checks out as safe and secure, there will be a public blessing of the play area. After that time children of the appropriate age will be allowed to enter and play.

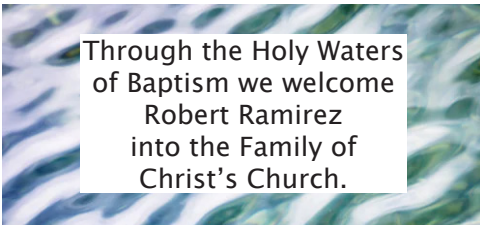
WORSHIP & SPIRITUALITY

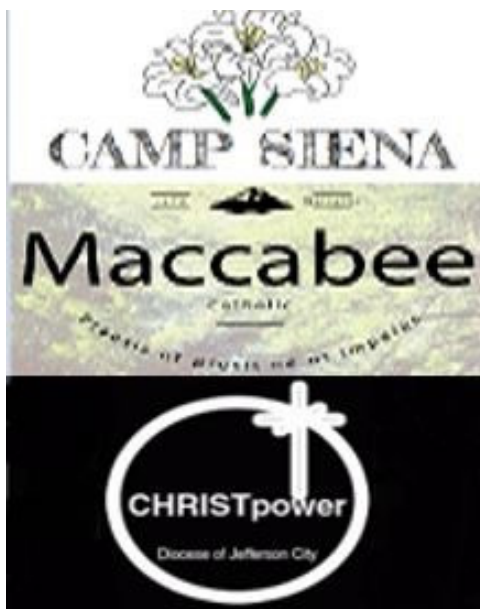
Camp Maccabee:
