Message from Msgr. Mak:

Corpus Christi Celebration:

On Sunday, June 23rd, the Church celebrates the gift of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On Holy Thursday, we commemorated the institution of the Eucharist in the somber setting of Holy Week. Corpus Christi invites us to reflect on the Eucharist in our daily lives here on earth. The Collect or opening prayer at Mass is our guide: "O God, you gave us this wonderful Sacrament as the memorial of your Passion. Grant us, we pray, so to revere the sacred mysteries of your Body and Blood that we may always experience in ourselves the fruits of your redemption. Who live and reign with God the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever." Note that this is a rare occasion when the Collect is addressed to God the Son, a fitting acclamation after the celebration of Pentecost and the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity the previous two Sundays.

The first sentence of the prayer teaches us that the Eucharist is a "memorial" of the Passion of Christ. This memorial is not a mere calling to mind or remembering. In the

scriptural and theological sense of memorial, there is an actual re-presentation or re-enactment of something that has happened before. This concept of memorial, rooted in the People of Israel's celebration of the Passover, finds its perfection in the memorial of the Eucharist. When we remember as God remembers, God becomes present to us. We participate in the divine agency of the Paschal Sacrifice and Resurrection of Christ: God visits his people and redeems them.

The petition of the prayer asks God to make our reverence an actual experience of the saving action of the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross. Corpus Christi reminds us all that our worship must involve our body, minds and souls. We don't just have an attitude of reverence, but by our reverent actions we

fittingly partake of the Body and Blood of Christ as true food for eternal life. We pray that we may always be conscious of the fruits of the Eucharist as we then give loving service to our brothers and sisters.

At the conclusion of the four masses that weekend, according to the ritual in the Roman Missal, there will be a procession throughout the Church. The Blessed Sacrament will remain in the ciborium on the altar through the prayer after communion. The priest will then incense the Blessed Sacrament, then, after putting on the humeral veil, will proceed through the main nave of the church, continuing throughout so that all may have the opportunity to reflect and venerate the Sacrament. The Eucharistic procession reminds us of Christ's desire to remain with us and his desire that we remain in him.

After the procession after the 10:00 AM mass, a Host will be placed in the monstrance and the Blessed Sacrament will remain on the altar for public veneration until concluding with Benediction at 5:30 PM. All parishioners are invited to spend at least some time in adoration of the blessed sacrament on that Sunday afternoon. The 6:00 PM Spanish Mass will also have a procession at the conclusion of Mass.
