Long Range Planning to Begin in the Parish

The Administration Commission at Our Lady of the Lake is tasked by its charter to manage the maintenance, improvement, and development of parish facilities. The day to day maintenance, repairs and replacements are well-cared for by our parish custodian John Riley, with the oversight and assistance of members of the Administration Commission, along with various service professionals as need arises.

The Commission is now focusing on the development of a long-range plan for the parish facilities. This plan will address problems with our current facilities, clarify the values we want to put into operation, and project what kind of bigger capital projects are necessary to address the priorities which will be identified. An example of a problem is the lack of easy access to the church for those who have mobility challenges. Another problem is traffic flow and parking for our facilities, especially on holiday weekends. Additionally, the increasing number of children in the parish is straining the capacity of our facilities to provide safe, hospitable, and amble rooms for religious education, both for youth and adults.

We would like everyone's input for this assessment. This includes both parishioners and visitors who come to church here throughout the year. To accomplish this, we would like all of you to think about the problems that you encounter when you are at Our Lady of the Lake church and on the property, and help us identify what needs to be better. We are not ready to consider solutions. We are requesting clear descriptions of the problems you encounter as a member of our community. We are very interested in how these issues affect your ability to engage in the mission and activity of the church. You may point out a lack. For example, the lack of a parish cemetery can greatly increase the stress that comes as we respond to our own mortality and that of our loved ones in the light of our faith.

Next weekend, I will be explaining the planning process in a little more detail at all the masses, especially as to a timeline for the information gathering period. There also will be an insert in the bulletin to provide you with a form for your

It may be a month until the first PSR class, but we are deeply involved in planning and improving our classroom approaches, liturgical instruction and, of course, working on the huge Confirmation program taking place this year. With the diocese moving Confirmation back to 7th grade, it is our task to Confirm all students in 9th-12th Grades. As of now, it looks like around 60 students!! The final celebration itself will include St Patrick in Laurie, and St Phillip in Versailles. I am absolutely thrilled with having so many families all together at once in our church! The Bishop has not yet announced his celebration dates and I will keep you posted on that.

First, we had a superb gathering at our First Annual Teacher Appreciation Dinner this past Wednesday night. Mrs. Maureen Gray, OFS led us in Centering Prayer (If you don't know about Centering Prayer, let me know and I will schedule another session or spend some time with you myself in the chapel. Being in God's presence, feeling His peace and gathering your heart and mind to Him is an amazing way to spend 20 minutes) AND, let's get real here....thirteen teachers, 20 minutes, no talking or moving around. I'm not sure which is more amazing; the prayer time, or 13 quiet teachers!

Then, we tackled brainstorming changes and improvements in PSR and Confirmation. I know for a fact that we were all inspired by the Holy Spirit after our prayer session. Everyone, even those who don't normally speak out, was animated and productive! Trust was evident in this group because most of them have worked together in PSR for several years. Again, we are so blessed to have these folks in charge of our classrooms!
