Long-Range Planning: Opportunity for Input

As introduced last weekend in the bulletin, the Administration Commission of Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Church is beginning the process of developing a long-range plan for our facilities. We will provide several different forums for parishioners to submit their input. The first of which will simply be a written survey that allows parishioners to state their immediate concerns, what they envision the parish to be for the future, and what type of priorities need to be addressed. We would like to define a five-year plan for the coming years for our church and worship spaces, the grounds, the parking lot, the religious education facilities, office and conference rooms, kitchen and dining facilities, safety and security, traffic and parking, accessibility issues, and the utilization of the full extent of our property boundary, among other things that might be identified.

In this issue of the bulletin and in the Fellowship Hall at the welcome center you will find a form to fill out with your comments, questions, and observations regarding the facilities at Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Church. While there are important

issues that you may be interested in or concerned about regarding the operation of the parish, how we worship, and how faith formation takes place, we would like to begin by examining the buildings and grounds. Parish management, policies and procedures, and parish leadership will also be part of a complementary pastoral plan that will be developed in line with the new initiative that Bishop McKnight is beginning in the Diocese of Jefferson City. At this time, we want to know of your concerns about the adequacy of our facilities to meet your needs. What problems have you identified when you come to our parish? How do these problems or limitations affect your ability to participate? What has been your experience in other parishes which might demonstrate an alternative or a solution to problems you encounter here at Our Lady of the Lake. What role would you like to play in becoming the solution to the problems you encounter? The following context may assist you in coming up with a comprehensive

response to these questions which we would like to have returned by August 31st.

The life of a Catholic Parish is ordered to several activities and roles. The first is the mission of the Church to evangelize the world by Word and Sacrament. We are heirs of the apostolic commission to go and baptize all nations in the name of the Sacred Trinity and teach all people the Good News of Jesus Christ, our redeemer. Every plan that we put into practice must serve this primary mission or we will fail to imitate Christ, who came not to be served, but to serve and to give his life for others. Second, we can't bring Christ to others unless we first hear the Word of God and put it into practice in our own lives. We must be formed in the faith and live a life worthy of our baptismal calling. We are called to personal holiness, to be in this world but to belong to God. This holiness can only be found through prayer, listening to God's Word—especially as it is brought to us by the tradition of the Catholic Church—sacramental grace, and charitable service to others. Finally, our mission can only be achieved by our unity as God's people. We are a church, the Body of Christ in the world. Our own individual needs and wants, but especially our suffering, find their fulfillment in the mutual concern and care we give to each other as brothers and sisters in the Lord.
