Let God Guide our Parenting

“Young people who stay connected to their Catholic faith are most influenced by their family’s: a) singing at church, b) witness of faith at home c) monetary donations to the church, d) choice of schools.” So, what’s your answer? This question is part of a KID’S QUIZ in this month’s issue of NCEA magazine that I give to catechists as resources for teaching your children. Another question is, “Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their?” a) neighbors b) priests, c) children or d) pets? If you look closely, any of the answers to either question could be at least a little correct, but I hope you answered b) witness of faith at home in the 1st question, and c) children in the 2nd.

I begin with a quiz because it requires deliberate thought. My prayer is that there is some reflection on your answers. I see many families slowly moving away from the certainty of our faith or reflecting on faith with our children. Proverbs 22:2 talks about raising children from their earliest days in the ways of God, and that those ways will guide them all their lives. There is NO uncertainty about parents being educators, role

models and motivators. God would not have blessed us with children had He not expected us to instill faith, love and hope in them.

Parents WANT their children to be in heaven with them, and parents WANT their children to be good Catholics and Christians. We WANT our children to be role models, to protect the weak, to look for justice and always show mercy. The world we live in often derides those characteristics because Christians may be perceived as too meek and mild, not strong and openly ambitious! We all know about ‘the meek inheriting the earth,’ but it is hard to confront so many situations where we feel like we must be the best, the loudest, the smartest or the most convincing. Our children are watching us ALL THE TIME! They learn by what we do, not what we tell them to do. That one has come back to bite me a couple times, and those were lessons learned the hard way. We will make mistakes in teaching our children, but learn from it and apologize, then move

on! That's being a good role model,
so model faith that takes them to
heaven with you, model mercy and
love towards everyone even if they
don't deserve it, model patience and
temperance. Then model choices
that allow time for God every single
day in prayer or discussion. That
alone will create joyful changes in
children!

Last question, "Families –siblings,
parents, grandparents– help each
other grow in faith throughout their
entire lives." True or False? You
know the answer to the question,
without a doubt! So why do we
routinely forget to give thanks, to
forgive, to expect proper behavior
of our children? We don't inten-
tionally forget any of these things!!
We love God! But we may be too
busy for God and His teachings.
We may be too busy to ensure
our children spend eternity in
heaven. Maybe even too busy to
take responsibility for parenting as
God intended. We don't MEAN TO!!
Sooo...It is time to give yourself
permission to purposely practice
and instill love, mercy and hope
within your family. Give yourself
permission to be happy in God's
ways of tenderness by extending
your hand to someone in need. Most
of all, give yourself permission to
adjust daily life to the pace where
you can balance faith and activities.
Your mental health, your faith and
family stability depend on you giving
yourself permission to parent as God
intended. Get involved in religious
education, volunteer in the parish
and community, and give children
a chance to heal others through
compassion and mercy. That healing
is received just as much as given,
cementing compassion and the
satisfaction of helping others. If half
the world helped just one person,
then both halves could be healed.
THAT would truly be the family God
intended!
