town of Andrew and Peter. Philip found Nathanael and told him, "We have found the one about whom Moses wrote in the law, and also the prophets, Jesus, son of Joseph, from Nazareth." But Nathanael said to him, "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" Philip said to him, "Come and see."

This passage is a wonderful introduction to the rest of the Gospel of John. In each chapter, we become privileged witnesses to people whose lives are changed by encountering Christ. People come face to face with the living God in Jesus Christ and immediately share their experience with others who in turn become Christ's disciples.

We have all heard that faith isn't complete until we have given it away. How true that is for any gift. To be able to share something with others is a sure sign that we feel secure in a blessing. In parable after parable, Jesus teaches us that the Kingdom of God is discovered in the very act of giving of oneself to another. All this teaching finds its culmination in the Cross of Jesus Christ, the sign that
