

Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) Procession after the weekend masses of June 2 & 3.

Celebrated the first Sunday after the feast of the Trinity. St. Juliana, a young Belgian nun in Retinne in the thirteenth century, while in prayer received the inspiration for a feast that celebrates and promotes the gift of the Real Presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist, and from that moment, the Feast of Corpus Christi spread throughout the province, continent, and world.

On Holy Thursday, we walk with Jesus to the Mount of Olives, to keep watch with him on the night of his betrayal. The sacrament is carried in the ciborium, covered with the humeral veil: and Christ's glory too, is veiled as he undergoes the Passion. On Corpus Christi, we walk in the afterglow of Easter-time, in company with the Risen Lord. This time, the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in a monstrance: the Lord's glory is not hidden, but visible to all. Corpus Christi is one of the most Catholic of days, an expression of our faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament.

Lord, I Know You Sent Me This Work

“Don’t worry about anything; pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God’s peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus”

I walked into my study and settled into my desk chair feeling overwhelmed. I was on a writing deadline for a project that involved translating a German letter to English. Initially, I was thrilled to accept this project but after I looked at the number of days left until the deadline and the amount of work left to do, it seemed to have become an insurmountable task. I said, “Lord, there is no way for me to get this work done on time.” And of course, the more time I spent dwelling on it and worrying, the further behind I became. I said, “Lord, I know you have sent me this work, I know I should trust you, but, I’m feeling panic.” The task I was facing was daunting, and this was haunting me and yet, I knew it was not impossible.

I love to feel the peace that happens when the work is done and all the pieces are in place and the sound track of my life is a Bach prelude. Yet, most of the time, when I think the people I care about sometimes are hurting and feel lonely just as I sometimes do, then my heart’s background music is closer to Chopin’s Minuet Waltz or Rimsky-Korsakov’s Flight of the Bumblebee. Yet, the verse in Philippians 4 has told me precisely what I need to accomplish, and thanksgiving, present your prayer requests to God. Yes indeed, what I needed was the peace of God that is only found in Christ Jesus. His peace infuses us even in the midst of stress. His love reassures us that we aren’t alone in a time of chaos. His strength holds back pressures that threaten to crush us in this mundane, fast paced world. Yes, Jesus is our loving and compassionate Lord. Even though the task I faced sounded insurmountable, it became surmountable because with God, nothing is insurmountable. All praise belongs to Jesus.

Faith Step: Have you ever faced something that seemed insurmountable in your life? Ask Jesus to help you and to guard your mind with His peace today. May the peace of God be with you.

The Catholic Church has been given the commandment to evangelize all peoples. It is our duty to spread the Good News of workings of the Holy Spirit among us. The Catholic Missourian is the primary print instrument the Diocese of Jefferson City uses to coordinate our efforts. In the past year, the Diocese has done surveys and focus groups to exam this issue. Even in this day of increased technology, surveys have shown that our core audience requires a print medium. Even as the Diocese expands its online presence, it is essential that we continue a printed newspaper, and to provide a newspaper, there has to be enough subscriptions to support it. Policy is that all parishes in the Diocese subsidize a copy for each of its families. This subsidy ensures that we are able to have a diocesan newspaper.
