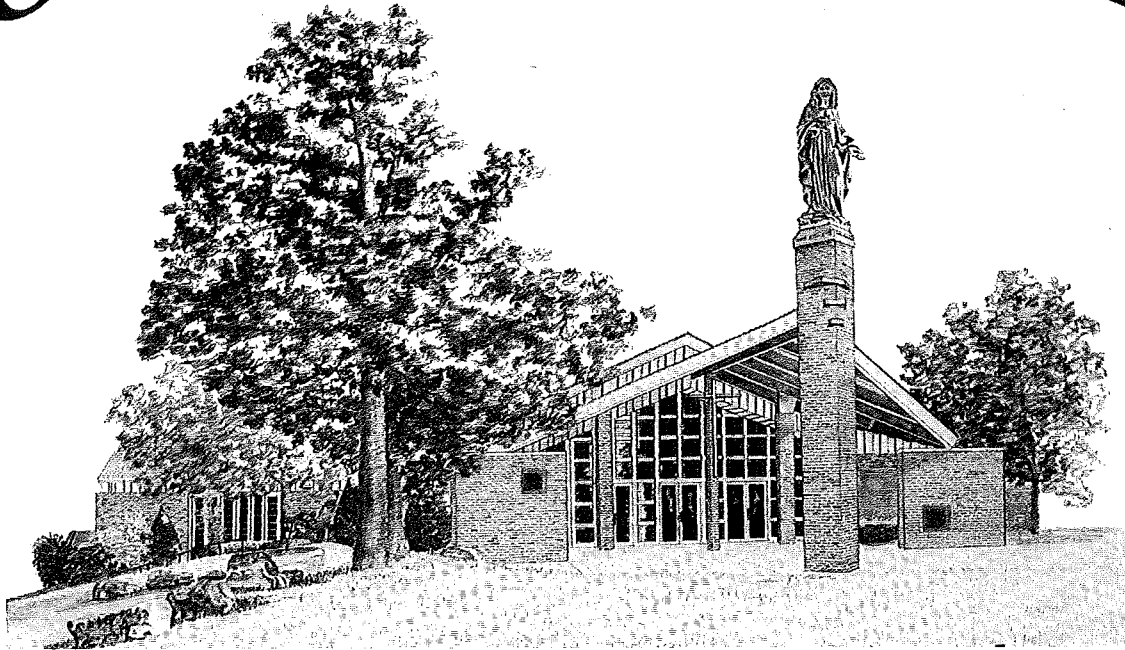

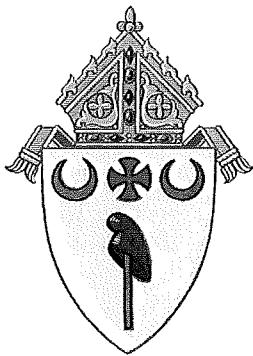



Log in to ConnectNow.

2. Select the **My Offering** tab.

5. To the left of **Electronic Statement**, click this button: . From the displayed list, select the link for the statement year.

The **Save As** dialog box opens.

6. Save the file to the desired location.
7. Double-click the file to open the statement.

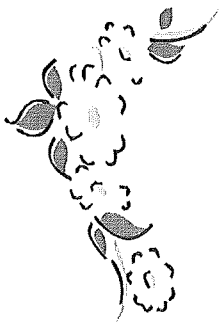

at the end of mass.

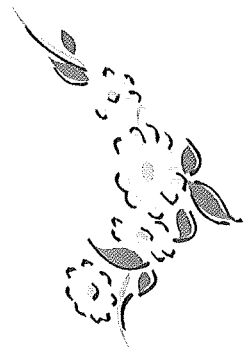
Friday, February 2, is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord,

Mass will be at 8AM on Friday, February 2nd.



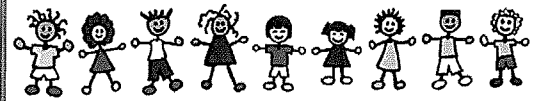
