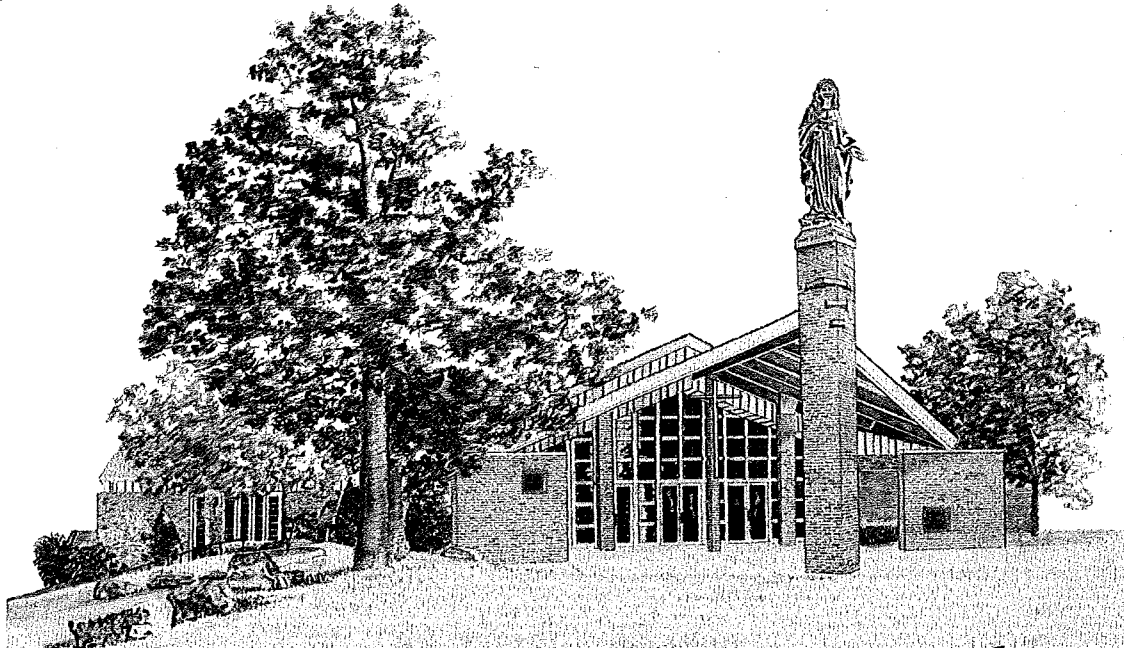

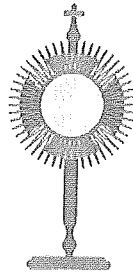
**As of 10/24/2017 Our Lady of the Lake has raised \$11,759.

#### **Adoption Records Law**

**ATTENTION: MISSOURI BIRTH PARENTS AND ADOPT- EES:** Missouri adoption law is changing! On **January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018**, adult adoptees (ages 18 and older) will be granted access to their original birth certificate. Birth parents have the right to protect their confidentiality under the new law, but they *must act before January 1<sup>st</sup>*.
