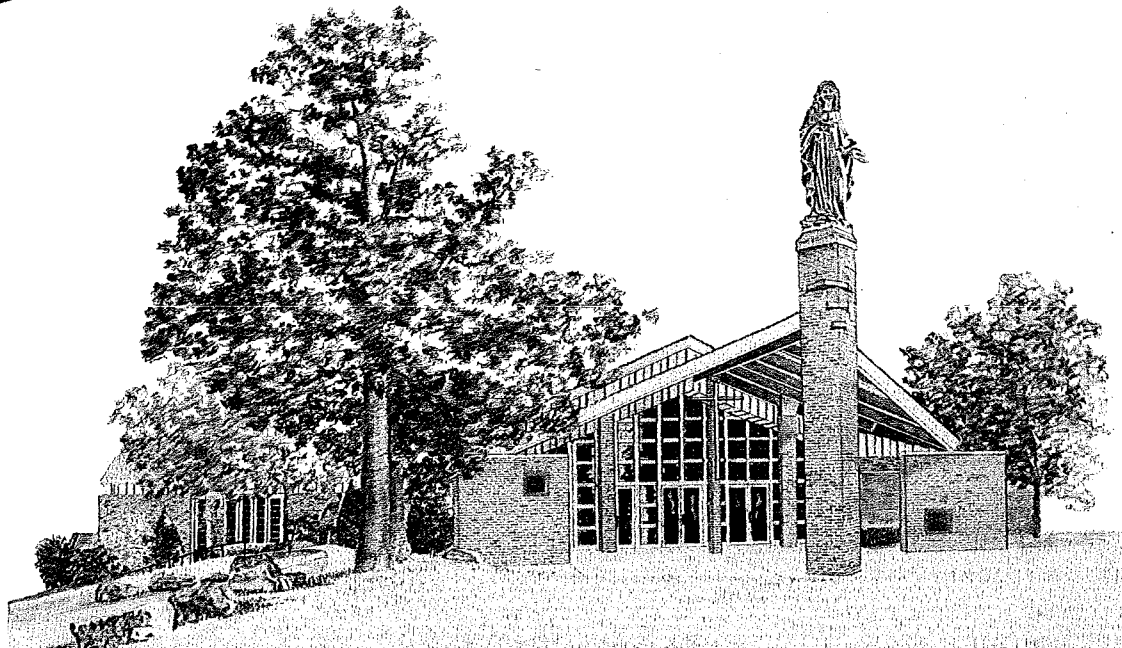

Despite initial concerns regarding Melissa’s future, she has not only survived but thrived! With a Master’s Degree in Social Work, Melissa has worked in the fields of substance abuse, mental health, domestic violence/ sexual assault counseling, and child welfare. The author of “You Carried Me: A Daughter’s Memoir,” Melissa has testified before both houses of Congress and the Australian Parliament. She founded The Abortion Survivors Network, and has advised over 209 abortion survivors. Years of searching for her biological family resulted in her offering them forgiveness. Melissa’s story is much more than a survival story.
