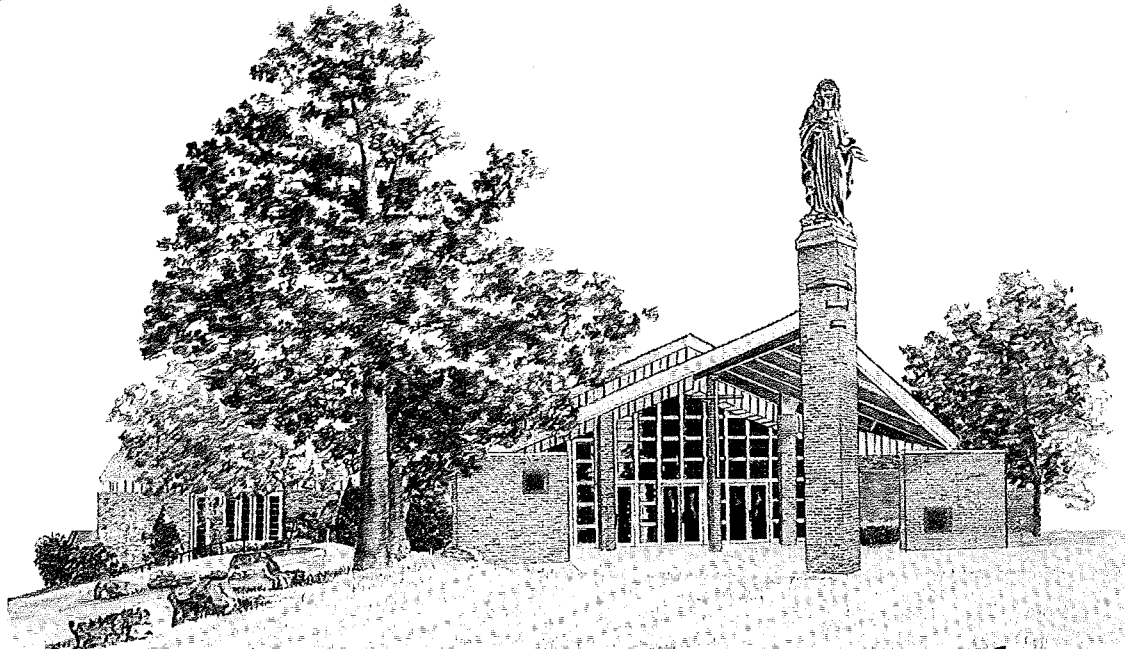

To Celebrate The 100th Anniversary (Centennial) Of The Miraculous Apparitions Of Our Lady Of Fatima, please join us in a PILGRIMAGE to St. Patrick in Laurie, Missouri on Saturday, October 7, 2017. We will gather at 8:15 a.m. at Our Lady of the Lake Fellowship area. We will then proceed over to St. Patrick in Laurie. Registration will begin at 9:00 a.m. The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available prior to the 11:00 a.m. Mass. Lunch will be provided followed by a guest speaker, praying together the rosary, Adoration of The Most Blessed Sacrament, a tour of the Shrine grounds and shopping in the gift shop. Office Entrance Landscaping Project: Work has begun on a landscaping project by the office entrance this past week. The scope of the project is to revive the existing sprinkler system so we can begin to improve the outside appearance of the facilities. We have such lovely landscaping at the entrance and exit of our facility and would like to improve the back. In addition to fixing the sprinkler system, the area in front of the religious education rooms will be leveled and a patio installed that will provide some seating and a place for visiting. We will also be removing the uneven sidewalks and replacing them with a level walkway. Finally the area will have some plantings to enhance the overall look of the back entrance. In the coming years we will be addressing additional areas to improve, especially the right, north east side of the office entrance.

Our Lady of the Lake Parish College Grant

Purpose

Our Lady of the Lake Parish would like to demonstrate support for the active participating youth in our parish that is pursuing an accredited college education. The parish will award grants up to a total of \$5,000 per year. The parish will award up to \$1,000 to qualifying applicants per college year (based on the number of applicants) to assist students in meeting their financial needs.

Criteria

To be eligible to receive the grant, the student must meet the following criteria:

- One must be a registered, active participating member of Our Lady of the Lake parish. An active participating member means that one participates in weekend Liturgy, involved in Our Lady of the Lake's CTC program and while attending college, one is active in the Newman Center or other college & youth ministry.
- One must submit a 300 to 500-word essay on what your Catholic faith means to you, how you see yourself as an active parishioner and how you apply your faith in your daily life.
- High school seniors must have a 3.0 or above GPA. College students must maintain a 2.5 or above GPA.
- Any high school graduate or college student enrolling full time in a post-secondary academic institution for the fall semester of 2014 is eligible. (This may be a four-year college, a community college or technical school.)
- One must be able to provide references from OLL youth minister, staff of the Newman Center or College Youth Ministry Office for further financial assistance.

This grant is disbursed in the spring semester upon verification of eligibility and renewable yearly, providing the above criteria are currently met and a new essay is submitted. The deadline for the 2017-18 grant is October 31, 2017. Applications are available at the Welcome Center.
