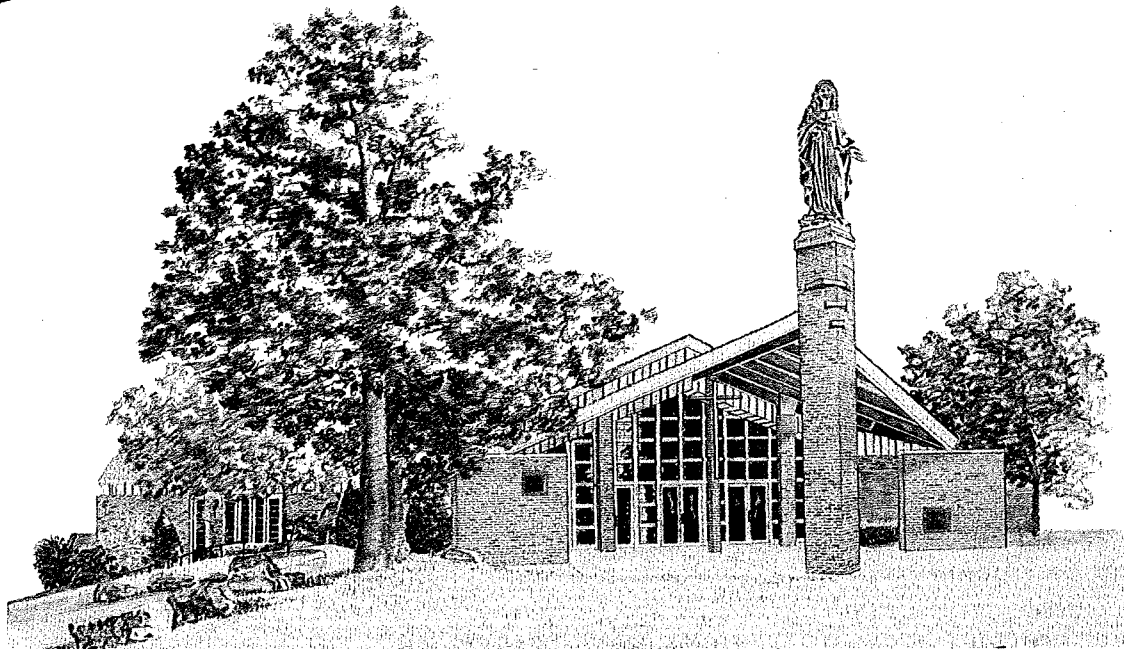

**There will be a second collection next weekend, **September 9/10**, for the relief efforts of Hurricane Harvey.**

“The devastation is horrific, and the needs are tremendous,” Bishop Gaydos noted. “We must step up and be a sacrificial answer to prayers, while continuing our own fervent intercession for all the people affected by this historic weather, its aftermath and the long recovery that will follow.”

Funds given to the collection will support the humanitarian and recovery efforts of Catholic Charities USA and will provide pastoral and rebuilding support to impacted dioceses through the USCCB. If donations are made by check, please make it out to the parish with “Hurricane Relief” in the memo field.

**An Invitation to Join the Catholic Church:** Fall is the customary time to begin the discernment, classes and preparation for those who are interested in joining the Church. The Rite of Christian Initiation is the program that guides the parish’s efforts to evangelize, baptize and catechize those who are not yet Christian or those Christians who are interested in becoming fully professed members of the Catholic Church. **Scripture Study Opportunity**

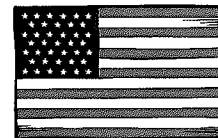
**How Jesus Became God** is the topic we will focus on in our next scripture study.
